NO POWER

Most patients think they are prepared for an emergency, but are you really?

Emergency Checklist

- Contact your facility to find out the plan for dialysis treatment.
- Keep a battery operated radio with extra batteries or a hand-crank radio in your emergency kit.
- Have a flash light with extra batteries in your emergency kit.
- Have extra charges for your cell phone.
- Throw out any refrigerated items after four hours. Frozen foods can be kept longer.
- Turn off all electric-powered items except one light, so you know when the power is restored.

THE FACTS

The process of dialysis requires a power source.

If power is out for more than four hours, refrigerated foods become unsafe.
