| Discussion Regarding National Earthquake Drill (Madras Fault) | <p>New information on a National Earthquake Drill was presented by Sherline Lee of the CDC. Sherline clarified that CDC is not the primary entity overseeing the drill and provided the name of Gerry Stines from HHS as a potential contact for further information. Currently, the drill is planned to take place on May 16-20, 2011 and is believed that the drill will have a primarily high-level federal focus and scope.</p> <p>A separate earthquake drill entitled, "<a href="#">The Great Central U.S. ShakeOut</a>" is scheduled to take place in Spring 2011 specifically, on April 28<sup>th</sup> at 10:15 a.m. ET. This drill will focus on the Madras fault located in the central and eastern portions of the country.
